A critically-acclaimed film about disappearances and other human rights violations in the Philippines. The film is directed by multi-awarded director Joel Lamangan from a script by Boni Ilagan, and stars Allen Dizon, Iza Calzado, and veteran actors Robert Arevalo, Gina Alajar and Snooky Serna.

Dukot was an official entry at the Montreal World Film Festival in 2009, receiving rave reviews from the critics. It has also been shown in regular theaters in the Philippines and has recently toured Japan, Hongkong, Canada, and the US. Dukot toured in several European cities beginning last week of October until around December 10 – International Human Rights Day. The film premiere in London is part of this European tour.

Joining the tour were Raymond Manalo and Mrs. Concepcion Empeño – members of the organization Desaparecidos and themselves victims of enforced disappearances. They have spoken on many events in UK about the film and about the phenomena of human rights violations in the Philippines.

The London premiere and the European tour are part of our efforts to increase awareness about the situation in the Philippines. We also aim to raise funds to support the work of human rights organizations *Desaparecidos*, *Hustisya!* And *Karapatan (Alliance for the Advancement of People's Rights)*.
